In modern times, with a higher degree of sophistication, one may use the **fingers to** substitute for binary digits, thus attaining a formidable **count** of 31 (= 11111 2) on one hand and the **count** of 1023 (= 1111111111 2) on two. There is a relatively straightforward way of counting to **10** on one hand and to 100 on two.

To count to 99 on your fingers, make fists and put them on the table. **Count** by extending your **fingers** from your closed fists, starting with your right index **finger** for the **count** of **1**. Lift your remaining right **fingers to count** up to 4, then touch your right thumb down to signify 5.

28. How High Can You Count On Your Fingers Science ABC

Since our **fingers** can only have two positions - open and closed - counting base **10** is difficult, if not impossible. We can use the binary system in which powers of 2 are assigned to the **fingers** and **1** represents an open **finger**, while 0 represents a closed **finger**.
